
## Approximately 7,000 Idahoans 12 and older used meth during the past year and 120,000 have used meth in their lifetimes<sup>1</sup>.



<sup>\*</sup>Psychostimulant-involved drug overdose deaths include intentional, unintentional, and undetermined intent from poisoning by and exposure to drugs, medicaments, and biological substances. These include methamphetamine, MDA, and Ecstasy. In 2015, 93% of death certificates categorized as deaths caused by psychostimulants reported methamphetamine<sup>3</sup>.
